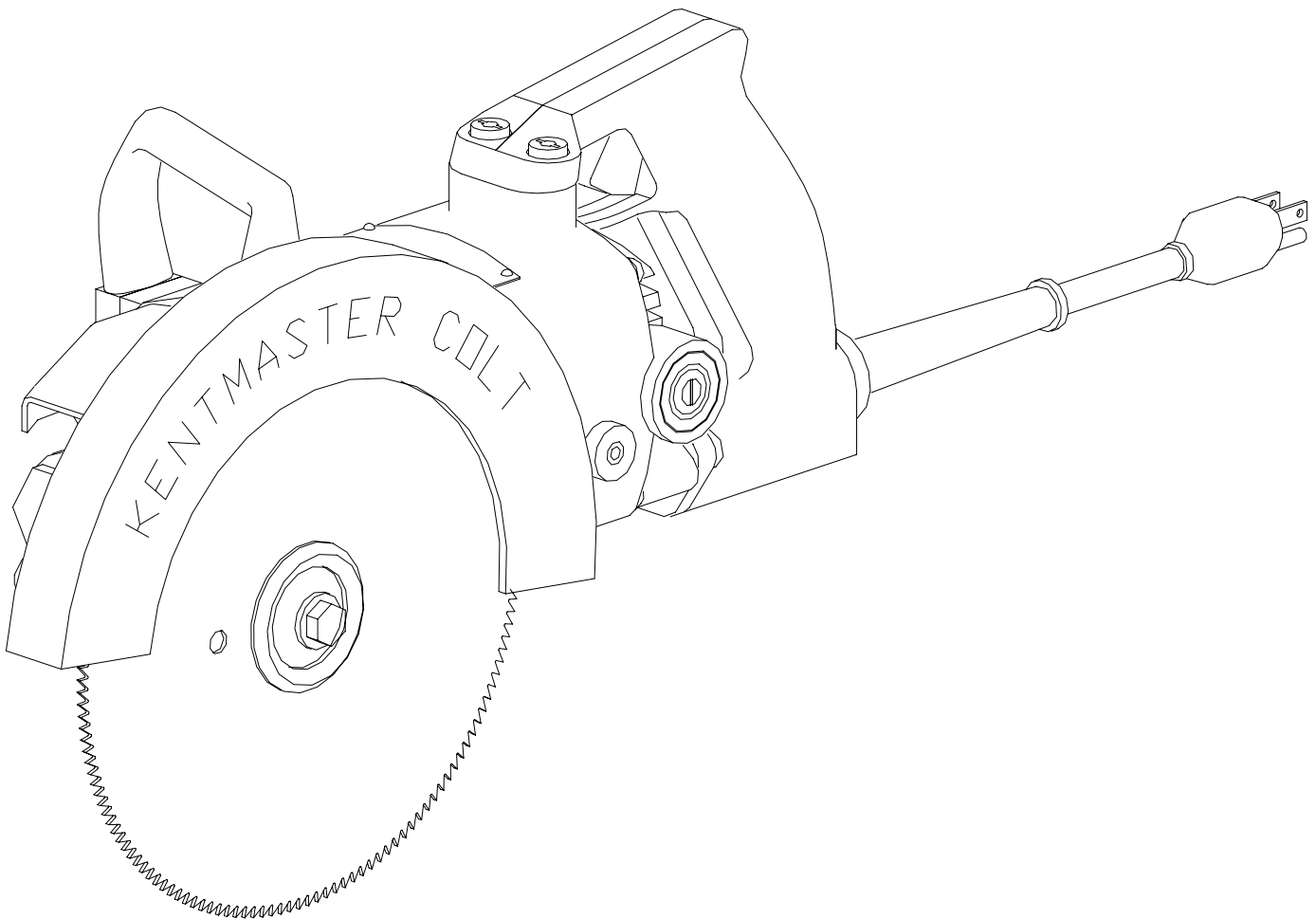

THE "COLT" IS AN EXTREMELY POWERFUL, FAST CUTTING MEAT SAW AND FOR MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE AND OPERATOR CONVENIENCE WE SUGGEST THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES BE FOLLOWED.

1. MAKE CERTAIN THE BLADE IS INSTALLED PROPERLY AND THE MACHINE IS CONNECTED TO A GROUNDED ELECTRICAL OUTLET.
2. ALWAYS OPERATE THE "COLT" USING BOTH HANDS AND PRESS THE MACHINE FIRMLY INTO WORK PIECE.
3. START THE MACHINE BEFORE ENTERING CUT. UPON STARTING, THE HIGH TORQUE WILL CAUSE THE MACHINE TO TWIST SLIGHTLY TO ONE SIDE.
4. COMPENSATE FOR THE TWIST AND FIRMLY BEGIN CUT, MOVING THE MACHINE BRISKLY ALONG THE DESIRED PATH.
5. OPERATE THE "COLT" AS PARALLEL TO THE WORK AS POSSIBLE TO UTILIZE THE MAXIMUM CUTTING DEPTH.
6. MAKE CERTAIN BLADE ROTATION HAS STOPPED BEFORE REMOVING THE MACHINE FROM THE WORK.
7. ALWAYS USE EXTREME SAFETY PRECAUTIONS WHEN USING POWER TOOLS.

MAINTENANCE

⚠ WARNING ONLY TRAINED AND QUALIFIED PERSONNEL ARE TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE TO THIS TOOL.

1. CLEANING

OCCASIONALLY WIPE THE CORD TO PREVENT DETERIORATION FROM OIL AND GREASE. CLEAN THE VENT HOLES OUT WITH COMPRESSED AIR. IF COMPRESSED AIR IS NOT AVAILABLE, PULL THE POWER PLUG FROM THE OUTLET AND CLEAN VENT HOLES WITH A BRUSH. THIS WILL KEEP MOTOR COOL AND ADD MOTOR LIFE.

2. LUBRICATION

LUBRICANTS ARE SPECIALLY COMPOUNDED TO GIVE MAXIMUM PROTECTION UNDER A WIDE VARIETY OF OPERATING CONDITIONS AND TEMPERATURES. USE ONLY KENTMASTER LUBRICANTS. SEE PARTS LIST.

1. ALWAYS CHECK THE OIL LEVEL BEFORE USING THE SAW.
2. REMOVE OIL PLUG USING SAME WRENCH USED TO REMOVE SAW BLADE.
3. OIL LEVEL SHOULD NEVER BE BELOW BOTTOM THREADS IN HOUSING.
4. WHEN ADDING OIL, FILL UNTIL OIL STARTS TO RUN OUT OF OIL HOLE AT ARROW HOUSING.
5. USE 80 OR 90 WEIGHT OIL.

NOTE: IF OIL IS EXTRA DIRTY OR THICK, REPLACE THE PLUG AND RUN THE SAW FOR ONE MINUTE TO WARM UP THE OIL. REMOVE THE OIL PLUG AND TURN SAW UPSIDE DOWN TO REMOVE ALL OIL. FILL HOUSING WITH KEROSENE. REPLACE PLUG AND RUN FOR ONE MINUTE TO FLUSH OUT THE GEAR HOUSING. DRAIN OUT THE KEROSENE AND ADD FRESH LUBRICANT. WITH A NEW SAW, CHANGE THE OIL AFTER THE FIRST HOURS OF USE.

3. MOTOR BRUSHES

CHECK MOTOR BRUSHES OFTEN AND KEEP THEM FREE FROM DUST AND DIRT. BRUSHES SHOULD BE REPLACED WHEN THEY HAVE WORN DOWN TO 3/16" IN LENGTH. THE BRUSHES SHOULD ALWAYS SLIDE FREELY IN THE BRUSH HOLDERS WITHOUT STICKING. TO CHECK BRUSHES:

1. DISCONNECT CORD FROM OUTLET.
2. UNSCREW ONE OF THE BRUSH CAPS ON THE MOTOR HOUSING.
3. LIFT OUT THE BRUSH: NOTE WHICH WAY IT FACES, SO THAT THE BRUSH CAN BE RETURNED TO ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.
4. CLEAN THE BRUSH HOLDER OPENING WITH COMPRESSED AIR OR CLEAN CLOTH.
5. REPLACE THE BRUSH AND CAP.
6. UNSCREW THE OTHER BRUSH CAP, AND REPEAT THE ABOVE OPERATION.

CHANGING BLADES

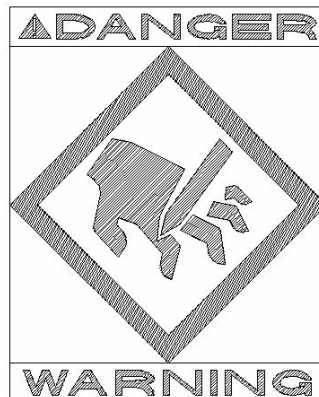
1. PRESS LOCK PIN TO LOCK SAW SHAFT
2. TO LOOSEN, TURN SAW STUD CLOCKWISE. STUD HAS LEFT HAND THREAD. (FOR STANDARD BLADE DIRECTION)
3. MOUNT BLADE WITH TEETH POINTING IN DIRECTION OF ROTATION. TIGHTEN SAW STUD AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE WITH FINGERS, THEN APPLY WRENCH AND TIGHTEN STUD TO POINT OF SLIGHT RESISTANCE.

IF THE BLADE SLIPS TOO MUCH DURING NORMAL USE, TIGHTEN STUD A BIT MORE. MAKE THESE ADJUSTMENTS EACH TIME YOU MOUNT A BLADE ON YOU SAW.

WHEN YOU ADJUST THE BLADE STUD PROPERLY, THE CLUTCH PERMITS THE SHAFT TO MAKE AN EXTRA ¼ TO ½ TURN IF THE BLADE MEETS EXCESSIVE RESISTANCE AND STOP SUDDENLY. THIS PROTECTS SAW COMPONENTS FROM "SHOCK OVERLOAD" AND LESSENS "KICKBACK" BY LETTING MOTOR, GEARS AND SHAFT STOP LESS ABRUPTLY IF BLADE SHOULD BIND OR JAM TO A STOP.
